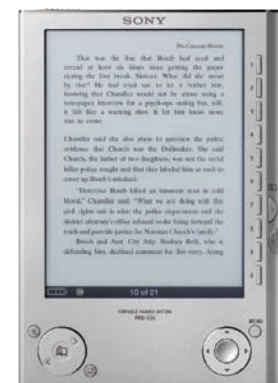

eBooks improve circulation - patron data

Everyone knows eBooks are convenient and portable. But did you know that adding eBooks can be a great way to increase turnover rates (the number of circulations divided by the number of items in the collection) without taking up shelf space? A large metropolitan library's eBooks annual turnover rate was twice that of the physical books. One US state's digital library saw an eBook turnover rate that was nearly six times higher than the state's average print turnover rate. If you buy eBooks, patrons will download.

Romancing the eBook reader

Overall, what's popular in print is often successful in the eBook format. Some of the most-circulated OverDrive eBook titles are often the same best sellers you see on Nielsen Book Scan or on Amazon. However, across all OverDrive libraries (and consistently over time), romance has been the most popular subject in all eBook formats.
