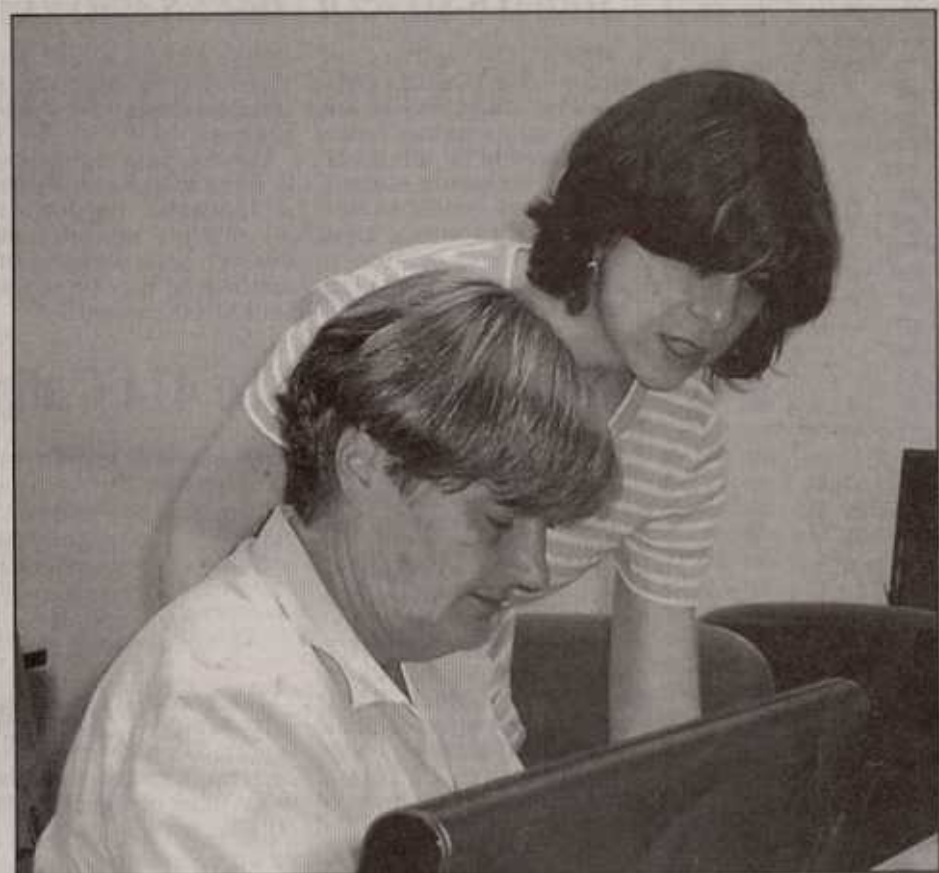

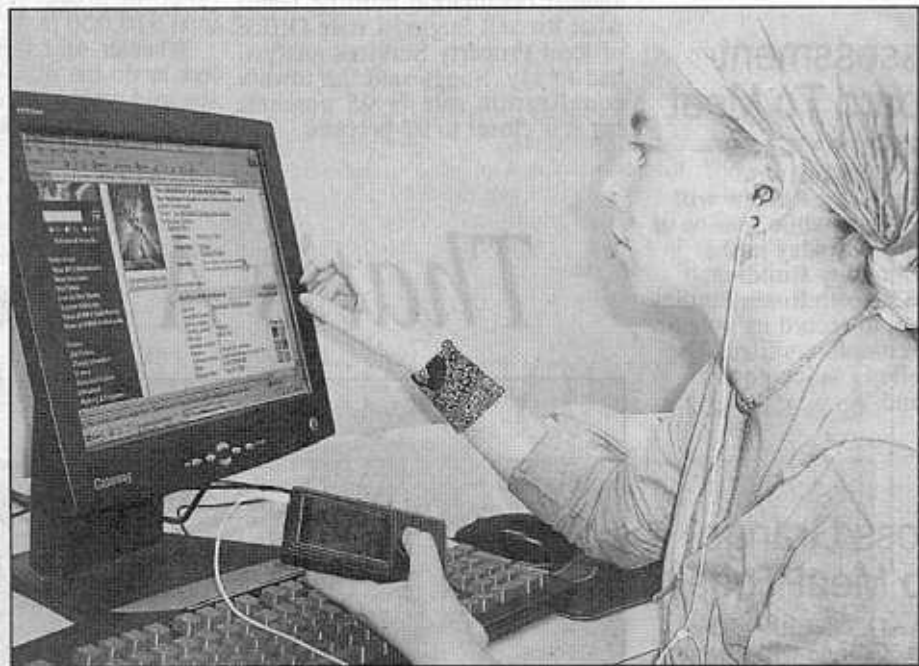
Prendergast To Offer Digital Audio Classes
